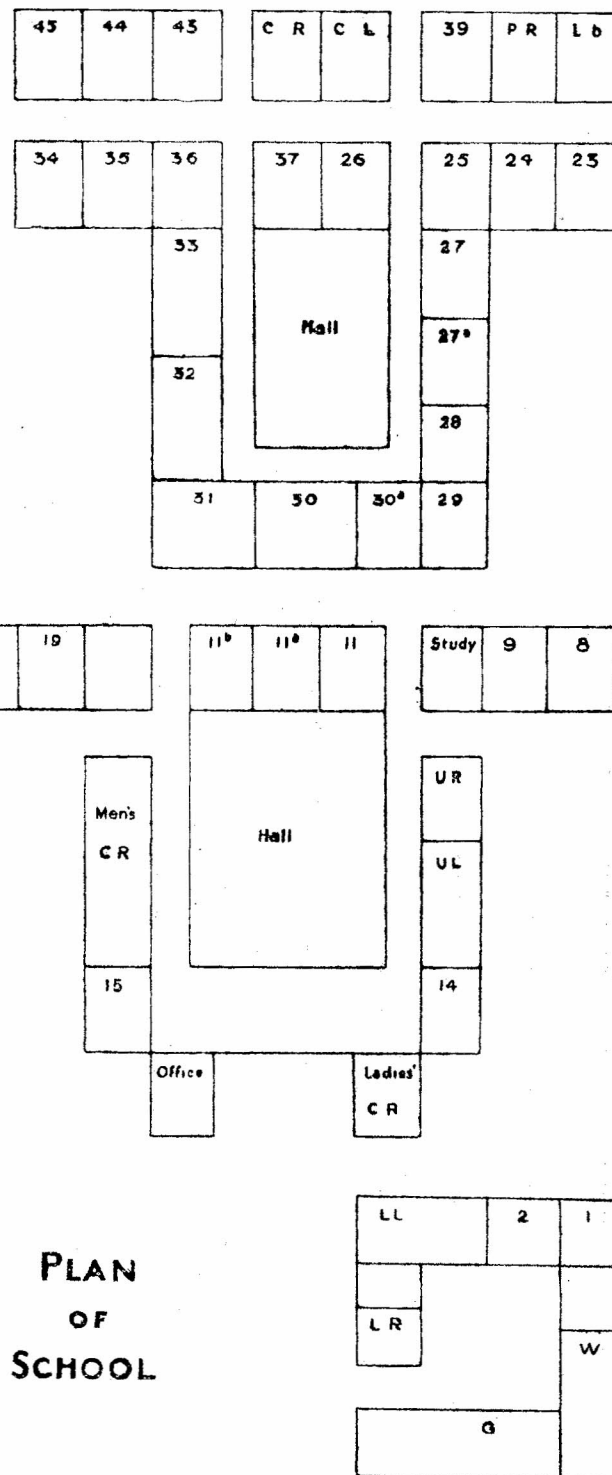

HOLIDAY CAMP AT TROUTAL.

The Camp at Troutal is held for three weeks during the summer holidays. The site is in the valley of the Duddon, one of the most beautiful of the Lakeland Valleys, about 3 miles above the village of Seathwaite. The nearest town is Broughton-in-Furness, about 10 miles distant.
