Entry into the Basic Section is open to all boys who will be fourteen years of age by 31st July, 1950.

Entry into the Army and Air Sections is limited to cadets who have graduated from the Basic Section by passing part I of the examination for Certificate 'A.'

There is a terminal subscription of 2/-, which covers fares on field days, shooting on both miniature and open ranges, etc.

Field days are held each term. Cadets are also afforded the opportunity to attend annual training camps for nine days at the end of July, and various courses of instruction during the Christmas and Easter holidays at Army depots and Royal Air Force stations throughout the country.

- (a) Lectures by external lecturers and by members of the Staff.

(b) Lectures by senior boys

(c) Film shows.

Excursions to factories and places of geographical interest take place periodically during the summer term.

Library in Room 37 contains many geographical magazines and travel pamphlets, contributions of which are always gratefully accepted. In addition, many Youth Hostel handbooks, Penguin Guides, and one-inch maps of the popular districts may be consulted. The library is open during the dinner-hour as follows:—
