Its members incur no further obligation as to military service than is required of other citizens during National Service. But numerous advantages are offered to those cadets who have Certificate 'A' and/or the R.A.F. Proficiency Certificate.

Entry into the Basic Section is open to all boys who will be fourteen years of age by 31st July, 1954.

Entry into the Army and Air Sections is limited to cadets who have graduated from the Basic Section by passing part I of the examination for Certificate 'A.'

There is an annual subscription of 6/-, which covers fares on field days, shooting on both miniature and open ranges, etc.

Training Camps are held during each of the holidays at Army Depots and R.A.F. Stations.
