The combined Cadet Force, controlled and organised jointly by the three Services, exists primarily to give pre-service training up to the standard of Certificate 'A' and the R.A.F. Proficiency Certificate.

It aims to inculcate the qualities of self-reliance, confidence, smartness, fitness, the art of leadership and command, and to foster the spirit of comradeship.

Its members incur no further obligation as to military service than is required of other citizens during National Service. But numerous advantages are offered to those cadets who have certificate 'A' and/or the R.A.F. Proficiency Certificate.

Entry into the Basic Section is open to all boys who will be fourteen years of age by 31st July, 1954.

Entry into the Army and Air Sections is limited to cadets who have graduated from the Basic Section by passing part I of the examination for Certificate 'A.'

There is an entrance fee of 10/- which covers fares on field days, shooting on both miniature and open ranges, etc., for as long as he remains a member of the contingent.

Training camps and courses are held during each of the school holidays at Army depots, R.A.F. stations, and aboard H.M. ships and shore establishments.
