Training in the C.C.F. follows closely the ideas embodied in the Outward Bound Movement. Camping, shooting, map reading, initiative tests and open-air exercises are all designed to increase a boy's powers of leadership and confidence in himself. They enable him to see a problem and tackle it by a positive course of action, to develop his critical faculties and to enable him to accept the constructive criticism of others.

Boys may apply to join the Corps on entering the Lower Fifth Form. A Basic Test is taken during the first year and later the Army or R.A.F. Proficiency Examination.

It is after the Proficiency Certificate stage that cadets receive the type of training most likely to develop their qualities of leadership and sense of responsibility.

During the holidays qualified cadets may attend courses, provided by the Army or R.A.F., where they may gain experience in Physical Training, Radio, Signalling, Automobile Engineering, Gliding, Flying, Meteorology, Navigation, Surveying, Life Saving, First Aid, Marksmanship and Civil Defence.
